

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

MAKE: Porsche

MODEL: 911 Carrera S (991)

YEAR: 2012-2016 **ENGINE:** H6-3.8L

Muffler Bypass Exhaust 49C36412



BEFORE STARTING ANY OF THE STEPS BELOW, ENSURE THAT THE VEHICLE IS COLD AND HAS NOT BEEN RUN FOR A MINIMUM OF 2 HOURS. ALWAYS WEAR EYE PROTECTION WHEN PERFORMING INSTALL.

- 1. Secure vehicle on jack stands (Refer to your manual for specified jack stand positions).
- 2. Remove the OE tips.
- **3.** Remove rear tail lights (Refer to your owner's manual).
- **4.** Remove bumper cover (Refer to your owner's manual).
- **5.** Remove left and right side muffler heat shields.
- **6.** Remove the left and right side muffler brackets secured to the exhaust manifolds and center muffler and then re-install the x4 nuts securing the center muffler to the exhaust manifolds without the brackets and tighten. The left and right brackets will not be re-used.
- 7. Loosen the left and right side muffler band clamps.
- 8. Remove the x2 nuts securing the left side OE muffler to the engine bracket. Remove left side OE muffler.
- 9. Remove the x2 nuts securing the right side OE muffler to the engine bracket. Remove right side OE muffler.
- **10.** Remove the left and right side muffler bracket, nut, bolt and spacer off the OE mufflers.
- 11. Install the left and right muffler brackets, nut, bolt and spacer onto the left and right side aFe muffler bypass pipes but do not tighten.
- **12.**Using the original band clamp (D0 NOT TIGHTEN), install the left side aFe muffler bypass pipe and x2 original nuts removed from step 8 and tighten.
- **13.** Using the original band clamp (DO NOT TIGHTEN), install the right side aFe muffler bypass pipe and x2 original nuts removed from step 9 and tighten.
- **14.** Tighten the left and right side band clamps and then the nut and bolt securing the left and right muffler brackets to the aFe muffler bypass pipes.
- **15.** Install the left and right side muffler heat shields.
- **16.** Install the rear bumper cover.
- **17.** Install the rear tail lights.
- **18.** Install the OE tips or aFe tip upgrade and tighten

NOTES:

• It is normal for the aFe Muffler Bypass Pipes to emit smoke for the first few minutes upon initial start-up.
