- Disconnect the negative battery terminal before proceeding.
- Retain factory parts for future use.

Refer to Figure A for Steps 1-4

- Step 1: Disconnect the MAF sensor connector and breather fitting.
- Step 2: Remove bolt securing the housing.
- Step 3: Loosen clamp at the throttle body.
- Step 4: For Challenger vehicle, pull the housing assembly as one piece outside of the vehicle.



Refer to Figure B for Step 5

Step 5: For Charger, open the housing and remove the factory filter. Then disconnect the inlet duct and pull the bottom part of the housing outside of the vehicle. (The inlet duct is not removable)





Refer to Figure C for Steps 6-9

- Step 6: Transfer the grommet from the factory airbox to the aFe housing.
- Step 7: Install trim seal at the bottom edge of the aFe housing.
- Step 8: Decide if you want to use the dry or oiled filters. Slide the selected filters inside the aFe housing until it locks in place. Install clamp on filter end but, do not tighten at this time.
- Step 9: For Challenger vehicle only, transfer the inlet duct to the aFe housing.



Refer to Figure D for Steps 10-11

Step 10: Make sure factory grommet is installed correctly into hole.

Step 11: Install aFe housing assembly into vehicle. For Charger only, re-connect factory inlet duct while installing the housing in.





Refer to Figure E for Step 12

Step 12: Remove the MAF sensor from factory housing. Install the sensor on the afe tube using the provided M4 screws.



Refer to Figure F for Step 13

Step 13: Install the coupling over the throttle body with the clamp. Do not tighten yet. Make sure it's oriented correctly.





Refer to Figure G for Steps 14-18

- Step 14: Install the aFe tube by sliding it first into the filter then into the coupling.
- Step 15: Make sure everything is aligned correctly, then tighten all clamps.
- Step 16: Reconnect the breather fitting by pushing it firmly into the coupling.
- Step 17: Re-install the bolt removed at Step 2 to secure the housing.
- Step 18: Reconnect the MAF sensor. Your installation is now complete.

NOTE: Check all clamps and connectors after 200 miles.

NOTE: Place enclosed CARB EO sticker on or near the device on a smooth, clean surface.

EO identification label is required to pass the smog test inspection.
