

Refer to Figure A for Step 1

Step 1: Disconnect the Mass Air Flow (MAF) harness.




Refer to Figure B for Steps 2-3

Step 2: Disconnect both hose on the Purge jet.

Step 3: With an upwards motion pull off the crank case line from the stock coupling.





Refer to Figure C for Step 4

Step 4: With A small flat head screwdriver unclip the harness holder and open to release the MAF harness free.



Refer to Figure D for Step 5

Step 5: Carefully remove the seal trim and retaining clips off the factory airbox.





Refer to Figure E for Steps 6-8

Step 6: Loosen the factory clamp on the silicone coupling.

- Step 7: Remove the four 10mm bolts securing the factory housing. Do not discard the bolts at this time they will be reused.
- Step 8: With an upward motion pull the factory intake system out of the vehicle.



Refer to Figure F for Steps 9-10


Step 9: Transfer one of the mounting grommet on the factory airbox to the Takeda housing. Step 10: Transfer the factory grommet from the bottom of the airbox to the Takeda housing.





Refer to Figure G for Steps 11-12

- Step 11: Using a Philips screw driver remove the MAF sensor from the factory intake tube and transfer to the Takeda intake tube using the supplied torx scews.
- Step 12: With a 10mm socket and wrench remove the purge jet off the factory intake tube. Transfer it to the Takeda intake tube and secure it with the factory bolts.




Refer to Figure H for Steps 13-14.

Step 13: Install the split loom over the exposed MAF wire harness.

Step 14: Install the Takeda housing into the engine bay, place the bottom grommet onto the factory peg.





Refer to Figure I for Steps 15-16

Step 15: Secure the housing to the rear mounting location using the bolt removed at Step 7.Step 16: Insert the Takeda air filter into the Takeda housing, assure the locking tabs are lock on the housing.



Refer to Figure J for Step 17

Step 17: Insert the factory crank case fitting into the supplied coupling and install with the clamps onto the turbo manifold inlet. Do not tighten clamps at this time.





Refer to Figure K for Steps 18-24

Step 18: Install the factory trim seal on the top edge of the Takeda housing.

- Step 19: Slide the Takeda intake tube into the air filter then slide it into the coupling.
- Step 20: Reconnect the two hoses on the purge jet accordingly.
- Step 21: Reconnect MAF sensor harness.
- Step 22: Align the intake tube with the air filter and coupling. Tighten all clamps.
- Step 23: Secure the front of the housing with the two other bolts removed at Step 7.
- Step 24: Make sure all clamps and connections are secured. Your installation is now completed.

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
